Viewing and accessing your blood test results

Online Services

By using our online services you can access your blood results and will be notified by the GP when they are available for viewing.

In order to apply for Online Services please submit a form from our website on:

NHS App

Use of the NHS App can grant you access to your blood results, where you will be able to see GP comments and print these results.



Website Request

You can send in a request via the website in order to be informed of your results. By accessing our website at:

You may request further information regarding your results. Please note that you will not need any log in details in order to send in a request.

What happens after the GP has reviewed your results

No further action

If they are normal and no further action is required then you will receive a message via text or you will be able to view this via your online services or NHS App. Please make sure we have up to date contact information so we can advise of these results appropriately.

Further action required

If your GP has reviewed your results and they either want you to have further tests or want to discuss your results with you, the Surgery will contact you to arrange this either via text or phone call. Follow up review appointments are arranged via the Surgery only and we allow longer for these appointments for discussion of your care in more detail.

By viewing your blood results as above and allowing us to arrange your follow up appointments you can help reduce the number of calls to the surgery and ensure that you receive the follow up care planned by your own GP.
